Thompson Rivers University, Williams
Lake campus, is in the process of
conducting a planned Needs Assessment
to identify gaps and opportunities to
support strategies to revitalize
educational opportunities strengthening
the TRU Williams Lake Campus and
Regional Centres in 100 Mile House and
Lillooet.

Cathy Carson is the principal of CCAR
Consulting and is a Williams Lake native
(although she has not resided locally for
many years) and understands the
regional culture and socio-economic
context. As well, she has extensive
administrative leadership experience in a
small public institution in the interior of
British Columbia and has worked with
local Bands and community groups in
that community and throughout the
Province.

Cathy has extensive experience in institutional research and reporting as well as enrolment management experience and worked with the Provincial Government on a variety of portfolios including performance measures, student outcomes and the Central Data Warehouse.

Throughout her career, she has focused on systems and processes to support student and institutional success.

Cathy will be conducting the TRU Needs Assessment, with a broad goal for an engaged community and a thriving campus.

Conducting a community needs assessment will help TRU gain a deeper understanding of the community needs and perspectives in order to prioritize resources, develop impactful initiatives, inform programming, and celebrate successes. The output from this Assessment will also signal to the community that TRU program and service decisions are well informed and responsive to the community.
